COURSE DESCRIPTION:

Continuing the study of grammatical construction, vocabulary, simple idioms, oral and written drills to illustrate the linguistic pattern of the Arabic language.

PREREQUISITES: ARA 101

EXPECTED COMPETENCIES:

Upon completion of this course, the student will be familiar with:

- Communicate in Arabic with native speakers of Arabic on a variety of everyday life topics, i.e. introducing oneself and others, describing people and things, giving and eliciting information, stating preferences, giving directions and describing locations, talking about daily activities, etc.
- Read authentic material on familiar topics with ease and reasonable speed.
- Listen and understand various authentic educated spoken Arabic.
- Write coherent sentences and paragraphs with accuracy.
- Recognize and understand various grammatical rules and their application in context.
- Expand cultural awareness through class discussion and reading materials.
- Proficiency in using basic sentence structure both verbal and nominal sentences, the structure of the past and present tense verb, and indicative, subjunctive, and jussive moods.

ASSESSMENT METHODS:

Student performance may be assessed by examination, quizzes, case studies, oral conversation, group discussion, oral presentations. The instructor reserves the option to employ one or more of these assessment methods during the course.
