COURSE DESCRIPTION:

Continuation of ART 131 with emphasis upon the use of the potter's wheel and related skills. Supplies cost extra. (Meets six hours per week)

PREREQUISITES: ART 131

EXPECTED COMPETENCIES:

Upon completion of this course, the student will be familiar with:

- A student's awareness, critical thinking, and problem solving abilities.
- Their manipulating skills with clay will improve substantially, as will their understanding of design, as well as their ability to express themselves in a creative and personal way.
- To achieve these outcomes by working with traditional clay hand tools, potter's wheel, glazes, and electric kilns. Students will improve their psycho-motor skills as well as their cognitive and affective understanding.

ASSESSMENT METHODS:

Student performance may be assessed by examination, quizzes, case studies, oral conversation, group discussion, oral presentations. The instructor reserves the option to employ one or more of these assessment methods during the course.
