COURSE DESCRIPTION:

Students will be introduced to the Bio-Medical profession and terminology. Usage, definition, pronunciation and spelling of terms related to anatomy, medical equipment, electronic test equipment and safety will be introduced. Students will become aware of the fundamentals of medical equipment and testing concepts.

EXPECTED COMPETENCIES:

- Illustrate the components of an ECG Waveform in relationship to a Blood Pressure Waveform.
- Demonstrate an understanding of how to utilize a Safety Analyzer.
- Demonstrate an understanding of how to utilize a Defibrillator Analyzer.
- Demonstrate an understanding of how to utilize a Non Invasive Blood Pressure Tester.
- Demonstrate an understanding of how to utilize a Patient Simulator.
- Identify safety precautions within a hospital setting.
