FPT 210 Fire Service Management I

CREDIT HOURS: 6.00

COURSE DESCRIPTION:

This program is designed to prepare fire fighters for advancement in the fire service. It is based on the Michigan Fire Fighters Training Council (MFFTC) Company Officer Prerequisite curriculum. Topics include Educational Methodology, Incident Safety, Incident Management and Strategy and Tactics. Students meeting all course requirements are eligible to continue on to the MFFTC Company Officer Course.

PREREQUISITE: MFTTC Fire Fighter II Certification and three years' experience on an organized fire department.

EXPECTED COMPETENCIES:

Upon completion of this course, the student will:

- Describe multiple Educational Methodology strategies
- Describe Incident Safety
- Describe how to direct Incident Management
- Describe different types of Strategies and Tactics

ASSESSMENT METHODS:

Student performance may be assessed by examination, quizzes, case studies, oral conversation, group discussion, oral presentations. The instructor reserves the option to employ one or more of these assessment methods during the course.
