GRM 102 Elementary German II

CREDIT HOURS: 4.00

CONTACT HOURS: 60.00

COURSE DESCRIPTION: This course is a continuation of Elementary German I and further builds listening, speaking, reading and writing skills within communicative contexts. Students will continue to expand their knowledge of pronunciation and grammatical principles, which can be applied to everyday conversational situations. Topics of Germanic culture will also be presented. A variety of technologies, media and other supplemental materials will be used to enhance learning.

PREREQUISITES: GRM 101

EXPECTED COMPETENCIES:

Upon completion of this course, the student will be familiar with:

- Have a deeper understanding of German and European geography
- Pronounce and use the German sound system correctly
- Demonstrate a knowledge of increasingly more complex grammatical structure
- Interpret common sentences, both written and oral

ASSESSMENT METHODS:

Student performance may be assessed by examination, quizzes, case studies, oral conversation, group discussion, oral presentations. The instructor reserves the option to employ one or more of these assessment methods during the course.
