## COURSE SYLLABUS

### GRM 201 Intermediate German I

---

**CREDIT HOURS:** 4.00

**CONTACT HOURS:** 60.00

**COURSE DESCRIPTION:** This course will focus on increasingly advanced German communication skills in a cultural context. It develops listening, speaking, reading and writing skills and deepens the students' knowledge of pronunciation and grammatical principles. Topics of Germanic culture will also be presented. A variety of technologies, media and other supplemental materials will be used to enhance learning.

**PREREQUISITES:** GRM 102

#### **EXPECTED COMPETENCIES:**

*Upon completion of this course, the student will be familiar with:*

- Demonstrate the mastery of the basic grammatical and syntactical structures of the German language and a sufficient vocabulary to be able to converse easily in German
- Illustrate a command of verbs in general
- Demonstrate a command of idiomatic expressions
- Present an impromptu speech in conversational German
- Demonstrate an understanding of literary material in German

#### **ASSESSMENT METHODS:**

Student performance may be assessed by examination, quizzes, case studies, oral conversation, group discussion, oral presentations. The instructor reserves the option to employ one or more of these assessment methods during the course.
