COURSE DESCRIPTION:

This course uses a thematic approach in examining philosophy, literature, drama, art and music.

EXPECTED COMPETENCIES:

- Discuss the importance of the art of humanities.
- Discuss a work of art as a creative form of aesthetic experiences and social significance.
- Analyze the cinema as a sensual, emotional, and intellectual form of human endeavor.
- Demonstrate that literature represents the necessary integration of ideas and skills, by which all human beings give order to their lives.
- Make informed judgments concerning sculptures and the inherent values that they represent.
- Demonstrate that levels of appreciation are determined by the relative degrees of participation.
