COURSE DESCRIPTION:

This course is an introduction to the vocabulary of music, basic terms, notation and appreciation. No credit for music majors.

EXPECTED COMPETENCIES:

Upon successful completion of this course, the student will:

- 1. Understand the basic materials and properties of music
- 2. Understand basic musical terminology
- 3. Understand the principles of musical structure
- 4. Understand the categories of musical literature
- 5. Understand the major approaches to music appreciation
- 6. Describe the human and mechanical agents of music
- 7. Distinguish between passive, sensuous, emotional and perceptive listening
- 8. Understand the development of perceptive listening
- 9. Explain the approaches and obstacles to appreciation
- 10. Review musical performances
