COURSE DESCRIPTION:

This course is a continuation of MUS 101 with increased emphasis on ear training.

PREREQUISITE: MUS 101

EXPECTED COMPETENCIES:

Upon successful completion of this course, the student will be able to:

- Build Triads on any degree of the major and minor scales.
- Spell the notes of any triad.
- Identify the typist.
- Label and name Triads harmonically.
- Construct Triads in open and close position.
- Double the correct note in different types of Triads.
- Construct inversions of Triads.
- Construct, identify, and label the Seventh and the Dominant Seventh Chord.
- Identify, label and construct Cadences.
- Identify and label non-harmonic tones.
- Harmonize simple Melodies.

ASSESSMENT METHODS:

Student performance may be assessed by examination, quizzes, case studies, oral conversation, group discussion, oral presentations. The instructor reserves the option to employ one or more of these assessment methods during the course.
