PDP 110 Design Concepts I – 2D Graphics

COURSE DESCRIPTION:

This introductory class in 2D design will teach the basics of 2D drawing creation utilizing state-of-the-art computer graphics systems and software leading to a broad understanding of the tools and techniques necessary to accurately design parts in a modern manufacturing environment.

PREREQUISITES: None

EXPECTED COMPETENCIES:

Upon successful completion of the course, the student will:

- Navigate user interface
- Establish screen settings (snap, grid, line font and color)
- Demonstrate file management proficiency (open, close and save files)
- Set work plane and change work views
- Create 2D geometric shapes, lines, arcs, points, circles and ellipses

ASSESSMENT METHODS:
