COURSE DESCRIPTION:

This course covers a review of essential grammatical principles and further development of reading skills and idiomatic usage.

PREREQUISITES: SPA 102

EXPECTED COMPETENCIES:

Upon the completion of this course the student will be able to:

- 1. Demonstrate the mastery of the basic grammatical and syntactical structures of the Spanish language and a sufficient vocabulary to be able to converse in Spanish
- 2. Demonstrate the knowledge of the subjunctive
- 3. Illustrate a command of verbs in general
- 4. Demonstrate a command of idiomatic expressions
- 5. Present an impromptu speech in conversational Spanish
- 6. Demonstrate an understanding of literary material in Spanish
