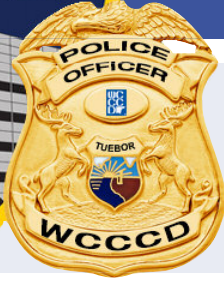


Wayne County Community College District's Police Authority Safety Tips



Personal safety is everyone's responsibility. Please remain alert and use common sense to protect yourself and others from becoming victims of crime.



When you are on campus, keep these safety tips in mind:



- Take the safest, not the fastest route
- Never walk alone, use the buddy system
- Know where the emergency telephones are located
- Stay alert to your surroundings and the actions of people around you
- Avoid displaying large amounts of cash or other tempting targets such as jewelry or expensive cell phones
- Always lock your car and keep valuables out of sight
- Check the back seat of your vehicle before getting in
- Park in a well lit and busy area
- Carry your purse or book bags close to your body
- Be alert and look around when using ATMs
- Store the Police Authority phone number in your cell phone
- Notify campus safety if you are studying or working late
- Don't leave your books, book bag, or purse unattended, even for a few minutes
- Don't let yourself be a threat to safety. Remember that violence is an unacceptable means of conflict resolution. The Police Authority, Administration, and Student Services are always ready to help students find effective, non-violent ways to resolve disagreements.
