Each year, students graduate from the Emergency Medical Technology – Paramedic program and are prepared to complete a national assessment through the Michigan Department of Community Health Bureau of Health Policy, Planning Access – EMS & Trauma Systems Section.

Upon completion, graduates are eligible to take a national assessment through the Michigan Department of Community Health Bureau of Health Policy, Planning Access – EMS & Trauma Systems Section. This assessment certifies WCCCD Emergency Medical Technology – Paramedic graduates to help them obtain employment within their field of study.
