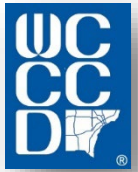
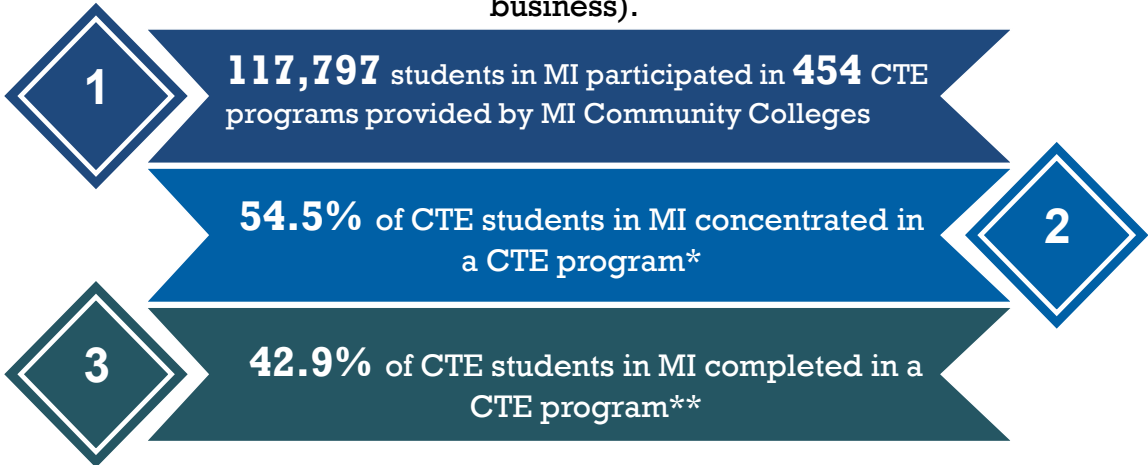


Career and Technical Education (CTE)

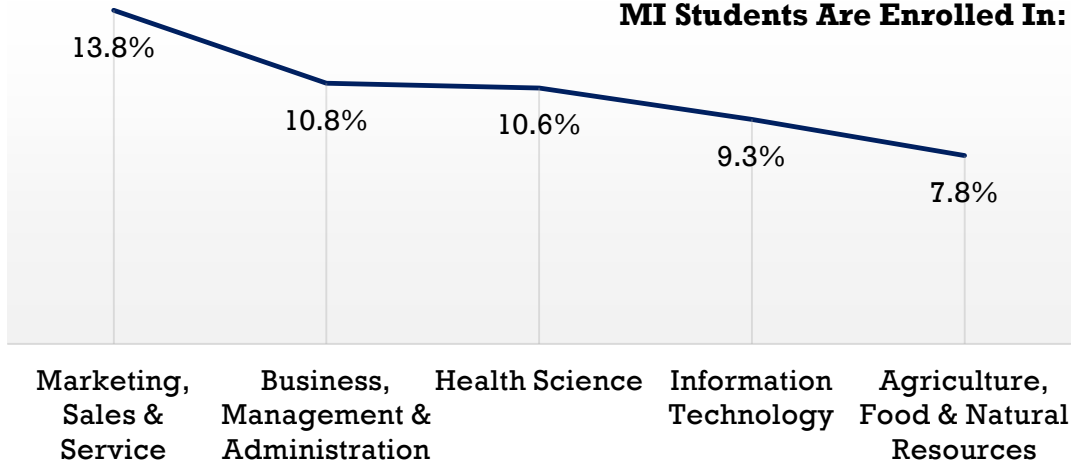


Definition of a Career and Technical Education (CTE) concentrator: a student who has enrolled in career program and earned three (3) or more credits in a CTE career pathway (e.g. health care or business).



*A concentrator is a student who has successfully completed more than two courses in a CTE program.
 **A completer is a student who has successfully completed all standards in a CTE program.
