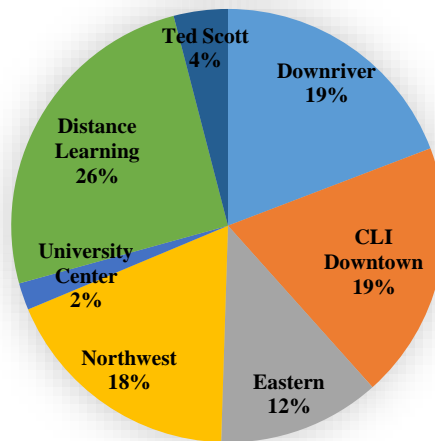
Cost of Attendance

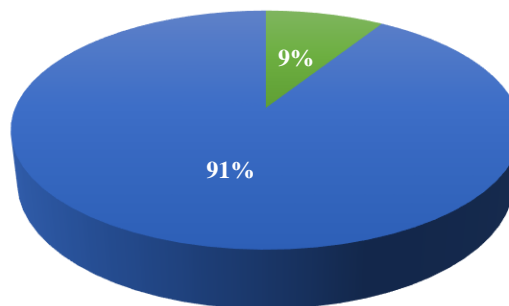
