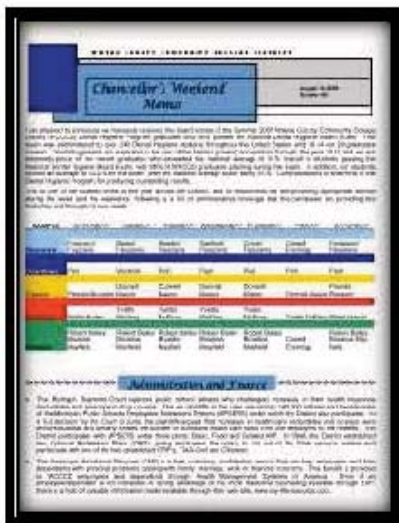
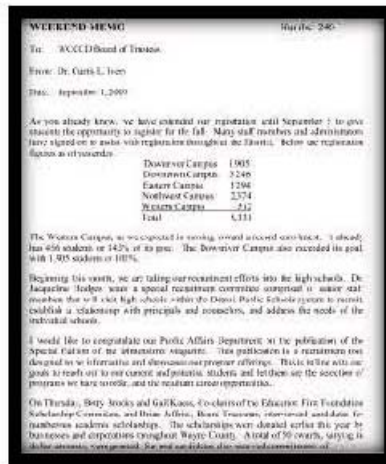
The new VoIP phone system has been installed!

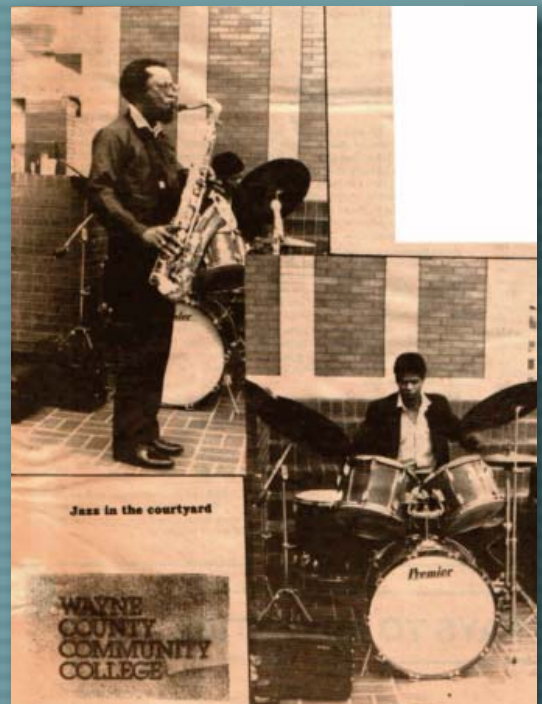


The atrium of the soon-to-open Western Regional Center



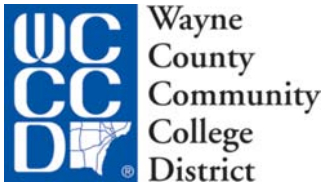
A 'whiz kid' at WCCC
